TEDC MISSION

The Tyler Economic Development Council (TEDC) is a non-profit organization that promotes the creation and retention of primary jobs for Tyler and the diversification of the economic base to expand employment opportunities in the region.

TEDC STRATEGY

Since its inception in 1989, TEDC has consistently and aggressively promoted business growth through a highly effective, four-point strategy:

- Retention and Expansion of Existing Businesses
- New and Small Business Development
- Targeted Marketing and Attraction of New Business
- Incentives and Infrastructure

The TEDC's focus is on primary employers; that is, companies that sell a majority of their products and services to markets outside our regional economy, thereby funneling those new dollars into our local economy.

TEDC FUNDING

Tyler Pipe

McWane Enterprises is a large manufacturing company headquartered in Birmingham, Alabama, with over 25 facilities throughout North America and the world. McWane operates a manufacturing facility in Tyler, Texas under the trade name Tyler Pipe. Tyler Pipe designs and develops cast iron soil pipes and pipe fittings for distribution throughout the United States and many foreign countries.

McWane's planned investment of \$36 million into its Smith County facility will allow the Company to enhance its existing manufacturing capabilities and to provide a stable employer for the citizens of Tyler/Smith County. The investment will include the replacement and enhancement of equipment throughout the facility. Tyler Pipe began construction on this project in Q3 of 2021 and will start production in Q2 of 2022.

Trane Technologies

Trane Technologies was incorporated in 1913 and is based in Davidson, NC. The company manufactures and markets heating and air ventilation equipment. Trane's Tyler facility, which opened in 1956 as an air conditioning plant, has since grown to become one of Tyler's largest businesses and strongest community supporters. The Tyler facility is one of the single largest Trane facilities in the world.

Trane is committed to retaining the 400 existing jobs that were housed in building "9," which recently collapsed during Winter Storm Uri. Trane plans to invest \$76.7 million to construct a new building and assembly lines at the Tyler facility as a result of the building 9 collapse. In addition to rebuilding 4 assembly lines, this investment will create 3 additional assembly lines. The investment will allow for improved internal and external material flow as well as improved labor productivity.
